PRIMARY MISSION STATEMENT:

To create a duplicatable, economically self-sustaining Mercury Free Extraction System, as well as Safety Education and Training for the A.S.G.M. (Artisan Small Scale Gold Mining) Community that conforms or exceeds proposed Legal, Governmental, U.N.D.P., and Minamata Convention Guidelines.

PREAMBLE

The US Non profit DBA Farmers of Gold was setup under the parent nonprofit The Cora Blue Fund EIN #81-2693582. specifically to support the Lolgorian, Kenya based Farmers of Gold Self Help Group Kenya license # 3777882 Both US and Kenya Farmers of Gold entities were created by Matt Hales, an American citizen who began his work in Kenya 5 years ago assisting the building and remodeling of boarding school dormitories in the area of the Maasai Mara, Narok County Kenya, for the nonprofit Cora Blue Fund, of which Matt was one of the original founding directors. 4 years ago Matt visited the local gold mines of lolgorian and decided to assist by starting his current projects Farmers Of Gold Self Help Group Kenya, and US non profit DBA Farmers of Gold.

Farmers of Gold Project saw through the formation and official registration of the Lolgorian Farmers of Gold Self Help Group, a community-based self-help group that is an umbrella cooperative for all the members of the Lolgorian mining community members. This group was founded in collaboration with the local elected board represented by the following; John Okello, the elected Chairman, Boniface Ole Kashu, the group secretary and Jeremy Ole Moonka, the Chief and Administrative Officer with tremendous support from the Chief Executive Officer, Matt Hales and his friends and partners from the US.

The executive board members above alongside other 12 board members saw the self-help group grow to be a well-established, duly registered and formalized group. The executive board led the community in acquiring all the government legal documents and licenses.





It's purpose is to create mass awareness to the mining community on the dangers of traditional gold extraction methods using mercury and to emphasize on safety precautions through training and provision of safety gear. Currently this is still an extremely overlooked humanitarian and environmental challenge that we have aggressively began to tackle with the full support and confidence of the Lolgorian local gold miners duly elected board.

We are currently working with the United Nations Development Programs (UNDP) Planet Gold Project, Solidaridad, The Kenya Ministry of Environment, and The Kenya Ministry of Mining, to assist in the transition of artisan mining to safer more profitable practices. Farmers of Gold is raising awareness and money from individuals and companies who have a serious interest in developing this sector. and who first and foremost care about improving the lives and health of these poverty stricken community.

Monetarily, Farmers of Gold has in the last two years through its private charity partners in the US raised an amount of Ksh. 7,000,000 all channelled to establishment of the project's objective of providing safety gear, training of the miners on safety and development and equipping of the Mercury Free Demonstration Plant. An electric Shaker-table has been installed at the Demonstration Plant and is open everyday for demonstration and mercury-free gold extraction.


We look forward to raise funds in a collaborative effort between our private sector, and potentially a percentage of grants thru the Kenyan government and United Nations Organs, specifically for the purpose to eliminate health risks of mercury poisoning from these artisan gold mining processes, of which these people do not know the risks and dangers, and sadly have no other choices of how to use it.

Farmers Of Gold intends to ensure that all proceeds realized from its Shaker Table Mercury Free Gold Extraction goes towards maintenance, subsidized safety gear, onsite safety training, and children of gold mining scholarship fund.

Plans are underway for Farmers Of Gold to create gold jewelry from our "Certified mercury free Gold", with a certificate of origin, to tell the story of how we are helping raise this economy for the Kenya people. Kenya gold for Kenyans. The high end jewelry will be targeted for the red carpet market to showcase on a global scale.





This project was launched in January 2018, after Matt visited the local artisan gold mines in Lolgorian Kenya, and saw there was a desperate need for safety assistance. Virtually no one was using any safety gear, as Matt was informed they could not afford it on such little income. In essence they are dying to survive. This is when Matt was inspired to do what he could to help this hard working mining community. After all, these were the families of the children who Cora Blue Fund was building dormitories for in the neighboring Olopikidong'oe Primary Boarding School.

Since January 2018 Matt returned with a great deal of safety gear for over 1000+ local miners, and in turn has won the trust of the people of Lolgorian, including the Member of the County Assembly (MCA). This project has even been getting attention from the national media including news stories on NTV, Citizen Tv, KTN News and articles in The Daily Nation and The Standard Newspaper, over the course of just a few months.







Farmers of Gold Self Help Group is duly registered with the government through the Ministry of East African Community, Labor and Social Protection as a Self-Help Project under the Certificate Registration number: 3777882.







Farmers of GoldTM has acquired all the crucial documents from Kenyan authorities required for its charity work and operations in Kenya. Officials from NEMA (National Environmental Management Authority) issued us our Environmental License after assessing our main site. We have also received our Mineral Processing and Dealers Licenses from the Ministry of Petroleum and Mining. This License covers members of the ASGM community of Lolgorian region, Narok County.

The Immigration Department issued a work-visa for the founder (Matt Hales) who is working to eliminate the use of mercury in gold extraction, and influencing the entire mining community of Lolgorian to adapt safety gear, proper training, and licensing for legal, ethical, and more profitable mining practices.

We embarked on a successful process of registering as Members over 2000 ASGM community members in Lolgorian region. This process enables all members to be issued with a membership ID that allowes them to work conveniently and with confidence as bona-fide members of our Self-Help Group.


